



Scenic View Campground COVID-19 Updates September 11, 2020

To our valued customers:

Although it will be different than in years past, we are fortunate that camping lends itself to social distancing. Whether it is enjoying a walk in our nature area, taking a long scenic drive, fishing in the Baker River, taking in the beautiful fall scenery or simply relaxing by the campfire there are many opportunities to social distance. We are currently open with limitations; this is a huge privilege and will require all campers to do their part. The safety of our customers and staff will remain our top priority. All reservations must be made in advance by phone. Walk in reservations will not be accepted.

While this is a very fluid situation, we will be reviewing our policies and make changes as needed to protect our customers and our employees. We ask that you understand that, due to concerns surrounding the COVID-19 outbreak, some facilities may be limited or closed based on current conditions/concerns. The changes to our operations and policies are as follow

Per Governor Sununu's orders we can now accept all out of state reservations. If you are coming from a state that is outside of New England you must complete a 14 day quarantine prior to coming to NH and sign an agreement upon arrival "attesting that all the person(s) staying at the lodging facility remained at a home for at least 14 days before arriving in New Hampshire, only going out for essential items and when outside of the home maintaining social distancing and wearing face masks when within less than 6 feet of another person during this 14 day "quarantine".

The store will be open to the public with masks required and social distancing. A limit of 4 persons are allowed in the store at one time. No children are allowed in the store without an adult. We will be utilizing a **self-check-in/check-out window**

Our bathhouse is open and tent camping is permitted. Visitors (day or overnight) will be permitted however store hours will be limited and visitors should be preregistered when possible.

Social distancing is in place and requires everyone to stay 6 ft apart while in public areas within the campground. Sites are limited to no more than 7 persons or less per site. Please keep this in mind at all times within the campground. Face masks must be worn in public areas when social distancing is not possible, be smart, stay 6 feet apart!

These are not actions that we take lightly and we realize that this will be a very different kind of camping season. If you have any doubt in your mind that these policies are not for you, we encourage you to cancel your reservation and visit when we aren't forced to adhere to these guidelines. Anyone in non-compliance will be removed from the park without refund. Please note these policies are everchanging and we will adapt as necessary. We will continue to closely monitor the guidelines and mandates set forth by state and federal agencies, keeping our customers and employees' safety at the forefront. Please check back for updates as they become available.

If you are sick or have been around others that have been sick or had COVID-19 symptoms, stay home! Give the office a call and we will work with you to reschedule your stay. We will do our part to help prevent the spread of COVID-19, but you must also do your part. By choosing to stay with us you are excepting full responsibility for your health and wellbeing of yourself and those included on your reservation. Scenic View Campground is not responsible for anyone who is or may become sick with a virus or illness.
